

Take Action against Modern Slavery

Trade Aid and World Vision respectfully request: That the House of Representatives, as a matter of urgency, enacts Modern Slavery legislation that requires public and private entities to report on the risks of modern slavery in their operations and supply chains, and on the actions they are taking to address those risks.

Petition reason: 40 million people globally are in modern slavery. Unlike many other countries, New Zealand has no legislation that requires companies to undertake due diligence looking into the risks of modern slavery within their supply chains and taking actions to address those risks. Modern slavery legislation is a key way for New Zealand companies to work together to eliminate modern slavery in private and public sector supply chains.
