- * Applicant agrees to enrol or has enrolled in a recognised programme / study with a youth focus or component.
- * In order to receive the scholarship, relevant documentation will have to be submitted (i.e. tax invoice, enrolment letter).

All completed applications must be endorsed by your Corps Officer/Centre Manager and sent to the Divisional/Regional Youth Secretary no later than 5.00pm on Friday 17th February 2023. The successful applicants will be notified by Friday 24th February 2023.
