Full Description of Project (including a description of how this project fits the Jeff Trust criteria)

To provide scholarships for six young people (underprivileged youth) and two leaders to attend a leadership camp at the Blue Mountain Adventure Centre. The project that we are applying for funding is part of a wider youth leadership development strategy at the corps for this year. We are investing in young people from the corps that show potential in leadership, and building positive outcomes for not only themselves, but others in the community. These young people meet monthly and also have mentorship with elder members of the youth leadership team.

The camp would offer the young men and women a fantastic opportunity to enhance their leadership potential, plan future goals (for further education or employment), gain better understanding of overcoming obstacles and gaining achievement, and help build resiliency. It would create a belief and understanding that they have a choice about their future, while feeling positive and comfortable about their identity. It would also give them time to explore the responsibility of leadership, what leadership style they are most likely to use and how to use leadership to help others positively.

This would include flying from City A to Wellington and back, and bussing from Wellington to BMAC and back, as well as registration fees for the camp. Each leader and youth will contribute \$200 through individual contributions and corps fundraising.

How this fits with The Jeff Farm Trust criteria points (d), (e) and (i):

The underprivileged youth that will be chosen to go will be picked from both within our Corps and our outreach programme here in this city, giving them the chance to be involved in experiences that they could otherwise not afford. The camp/project will be an adventure based camp, it is a camping programme run by the Salvation Army, and it is part of a retreat factored into the leadership development programme.

Also it fits by:

- An adventure based training model, involving youth in camps
- Work with under privileged youth
- Leadership development

Expected Outcomes

- Young people would return more resilient to the challenges they face in their community
- Young people would set achievable goals that our team can then journey with on returning from camp.
- Young people will experience God through nature, adventure and impact them long-term.
- Young people will experience living in a community whose focus is Jesus Christ.
- Young people will learn more about God and his involvement in their lives.
- Young people will improve their confidence.
- Young people will learn to work as a team.
- Young people will be extending their friend base to having a New Zealand wide connected network of both Christians and non-Christians.

Outcome Measures

- The young people will be interested in learning more about God and possibly express desire to make a commitment to following Jesus.
- The young people will show confidence in communicating positively with their peers.
- Their Parents and Teachers may notice a good change in the young people.
- The young people will noticeably work better amongst their peers and family at programmes back in their home community.
- The young people will have a new group of friends both Christians and non-Christians from around New Zealand who have shared in a special and unique adventure.

The project/camp would be evaluated by students, facilitator and youth team staff. Each participant is monitored by facilitator and mentor as the programme is followed throughout the year. Also each participant is given a survey to complete and reflect on at the beginning of programme and at the end.
